Horse-drawn Wagon & Carriage Rides

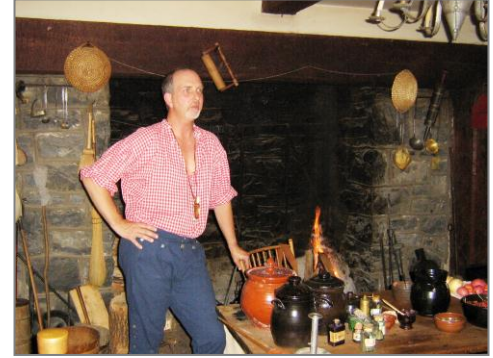
Our wagons and carriages are pulled by historic breeds of draft horses including Belgians, Percherons and Clydesdales. For your wedding, you may choose to have your wedding party and guests picked up from the parking lot and taken to the ceremony. After the ceremony, you and your guests will enjoy a leisurely ride through the village grounds and get lots of photos in the carriage. Or just use the time after the ceremony for photos and rides around the site. Imagine riding up in a lovely, white Vis-A-Vis carriage with a beautiful Belgian horse leading the way. Carriage rides are for 2 hours and for wedding party and guests' enjoyment.

Requests to rent the carriage must be made no later than 60 days prior to the date of your event. Requests made after 60 days are not guaranteed.

Rent-a-Piece of History

Select any four of the following historic buildings complete with costumed interpretation and demonstrations.

- Textile Process in the Textile Gallery – learn how flax and wool were prepared, spun and woven into fabric during the 1800s.
- Crafting Firearms in the Gun Shop
- Cooking historic recipes in the Tavern – experience firsthand the traditional way of baking over an open hearth.
- Operation of an Old Country Store
- Watching the Potter in the Pottery Shop – watch the potter throw clay and make bowls, plates and cups.
- Crafting tin in the Tin Shop – the tinsmith will show you how to fashion unique items from this versatile metal.
- Storytelling in the historic Landis Valley House Hotel
- Hand forging in the Blacksmith Shop – see how hot fire and brute force transform metal into useful objects such as horseshoes.
- An 1890s lesson in the Maple Grove one-room Schoolhouse
