

HEIRLOOM SEED PROJECT

Established thirty years ago at the Landis Valley Village & Farm Museum, the Heirloom Seed Project focuses on seed preservation. We grow and save seeds from heirloom varieties of vegetables, many with historical significance for Pennsylvania Germans since the 1700's.

The Heirloom Seed Project is staffed primarily by volunteers who tend the gardens and preserve and package the heirloom seeds.

Heirloom or open-pollinated fruit brings our history into the present with flavors and beauty from the past. Unlike hybrid plants, gardeners can save seeds from heirloom varieties with the assurance that the fruit from each new generation of plants will bear fruit true to the fruit from the past seasons.

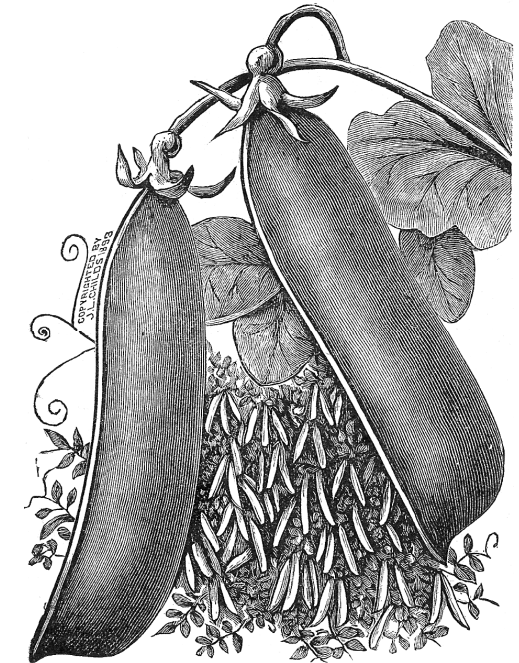
